NOTICE OF INTENTION

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN MONMOUTHSHIRE – TOUR OF BRITAIN 2025 STAGE 5) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that due to a special event being held, **MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** intends to make the above-mentioned Temporary Order, acting with the consent of the Welsh Government, the South Wales Trunk Road Agent and following consultation with Gwent Police, for the purpose of holding a special event (**Tour of Britain 2025 – Stage 5**). The effect of the Order will be to impose the following temporary restrictions:-

- I. Prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding along the lengths of roads specified in schedule 1 to this Notice (including the junctions linking such roads) except such vehicles in relation to the Tour of Britain 2025 Stage 5 (the Event). Such restriction shall also apply in relation to equestrians and to the leading or driving of horses or any other animals.
- II. Prohibit all vehicles from entering or proceeding along the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice (including the junctions linking such roads) except such vehicles in relation to the organisers, the competitors or support vehicles of the Event. The roads listed under this article and schedule shall be subject to a rolling road closure coordinated by the event organisers, outriders and the Gwent police at the approximate times given in the schedule.
- III. **No person shall** permit any vehicle to wait or park at any time along the sides of the road in the locations listed under Schedule 3 to this order and as set out in the order plans.
- IV. No provision of this order shall apply vehicles connected to the emergency services, police, fire brigade, ambulance purposes, and for organisations responsible for dealing with the loss of supplies of gas electricity water or electronic communications, to premises in the area and for the removal of any obstruction in the traffic, which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into a section of the Roads.
- V. All provisions relating to speed limits either by Order or by virtue of street lighting (Restricted Roads), with the consent of the Welsh Ministers will be suspended on the roads specified in Schedules 1 and 2 in so far as they relate to any vehicle used in conjunction with and for the duration of the Event.
- VI. The relevant sections of any existing Orders relating to the said lengths of roads will be suspended for the period of this Temporary Order insofar as they affect the said lengths of roads and the alternative route, and for the avoidance of doubt this shall prevail for the duration of the Order.
- VII. Such restrictions shall also apply in relation to equestrians and to the leading or driving of horses or any other animals.
- VIII. The times for implementation of the prohibitions and times for reopening are approximate and will be subject to variation dependant of the progress of 'the Event' but shall be limited to the **6**th **September 2025**.
 - IX. The Order will be in effect between 06:30- 18:30 on Saturday 6th September 2025
 - The order shall be cited as the Various Roads in Monmouthshire Tour of Britain 2025 (Stage

SCHEDULE 1-: HIGHWAYS TO BE CLOSED

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the roads or lengths of road specified below between the hours of 06:30 and 18:30 on Saturday the 6th September 2025.

B4246 BLAENAVON ROAD, GOVILON

Road to be closed ~0.70km west from its junction with the B4246 Merthyr Road to the B4246 Abergavenny Road for approximately ~4.25km in distance, the closure will proceed into Torfaen County Borough Council boundary where Torfaen County Borough Council will be closing a section of the B4246 Abergavenny Road.

R50 BLAENAVON TO LLANELLEN, GOVILON

Road to be closed east from its junction with the B4246 Blaenavon Road to its junction with Cefn Y Coed Road for approximately ~3.80km in distance.

A signed diversion route will be in place as follows :-

Diversion A: B4246, A465, A467, B4248 and vice versa

Diversion B: Derwen Deg, Station Road, B4246, A465, A467, B4248 and vice versa

SCHEDULE 2: HIGHWAYS SUBJECT TO ROLLING ROAD CLOSURE

The lengths of highway specified in this schedule shall be subject to a rolling road closure. During the rolling road closure, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the sections of road specified while they are temporarily closed for the safe passage of race participants, official vehicles and authorised persons, such closure moving in the direction of the race and lasting only for such time as is necessary for the safe passage of the event.
